

ARTICLE 7 – MEETINGS OF EHDN

- 7.1. Plenary Meetings. EHDN shall hold a Plenary Meeting not less frequently than every second year to provide an opportunity for meetings of EHDN members and working groups, and Executive, standing and *ad hoc* committees. The Plenary Meeting may also include scientific presentations, reviews and other sessions related to Huntington's disease. At the Plenary Meeting there shall be a meeting of the EHDN membership for the purpose of
- receiving the report of the Executive Committee,
 - holding elections,
 - if necessary, amending this Constitution
- 7.2. Working Groups; Meetings. Members of EHDN are invited to organize peer groups to address particular topics of relevance to the mission of the EHDN. Proposals may be submitted to Central Coordination. The Executive Committee will decide on support for the Working Group meetings and other activities.
- 7.3. Science and Education Meetings. EHDN may organize and sponsor scientific and educational meetings as directed by the Executive Committee.
